Spring and thawing are coming... so be sure to "Pump up"

- Take down the name, address, telephone number and driver's license number of the other driver.
- Record their insurance company and policy number.

- Write down the make, model and license number of the other vehicle.
- Take a picture of the accident scene, vehicles involved and especially note any damage to vehicles.
- Note the intersection, driving conditions and circumstances that led to the accident.
