



2025 Scholarship Program Guidelines

Application Deadline: August 31st, 2025

Overview

- Established in 2020 to support students in the communities where Maple Mutual operates
- Sponsored and funded by Maple Mutual Insurance
- Maple Mutual Insurance will be offering six scholarships for \$1000 each annually
- One scholarship will be granted to a Dresden area resident and five to other areas

Eligibility

- Students must be enrolled at a Canadian or American (U.S.A) university or college as a full time student in the current year of the awarding scholarship. The program is available to anyone attending, not just first year students.
- Children of staff, agents and directors of Maple Mutual Insurance do not qualify for this award.
- Student must have a connection to Maple Mutual Insurance by being a policyholder, a child of a policyholder or a grandchild of a policyholder

Conditions

- Please share your thoughts on the following question in a format that best suits your skills and interests (ie. essay of approximately 750 words, video, presentation, artwork, etc.). Original thoughts only, no AI Generated material. AI Generated entries will be excluded!
 - “Discuss ways in which Volunteerism can help with homelessness in your community?”
- Award winners will be required to provide proof of enrolment from the Registrar’s office in a full time post-secondary educational program prior to scholarship funds being released.
- Award winners will be required to provide their social insurance number (SIN) for tax purposes.
- Scholarship award winners will be notified by November 1st.
