



2026 Scholarship Program Guidelines

Application Deadline: September 11th, 2026

Overview

- Established in 2020 to support students in the communities where Maple Mutual operates.
- Sponsored and funded by Maple Mutual Insurance.
- Maple Mutual Insurance will be offering six scholarships of \$1,000 each annually.
- One scholarship will be awarded to a Dresden-area resident, with the remaining five awarded to residents of other areas.

Eligibility

- Students must be enrolled full-time at a Canadian university or college during the year in which the scholarship is awarded. The program is open to students in any year of study, not just first-year students.
- Children of staff, agents, and directors of Maple Mutual Insurance do not qualify for this award.
- Students must have a connection to Maple Mutual Insurance by being a policyholder, the child of a policyholder, or the grandchild of a policyholder.

Conditions

- The application must be fully completed and received by Maple Mutual no later than September 11th, 2026, either by email at goodwill@maplemutual.com or by mail to:

- Please share your thoughts on the following question in a format that best suits your skills and interests, such as an essay of approximately 1,000 words, a video no longer than two minutes, a presentation, artwork, etc. Original thoughts only. AI-generated material or entries will not be accepted.

- Award winners will be required to provide proof of enrolment from the Registrar’s Office in a full-time post-secondary educational program before scholarship funds are released.
- Award winners will be required to provide their Social Insurance Number (SIN) for tax purposes.
- Scholarship winners will be notified by November 1st, 2026.
